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## **Windows 10 Hello Face Recognition can be Fooled with Photos**

Windows 10 Creators Update's facial recognition security feature, Hello, can be spoofed with a photograph. The vulnerability was announced by German pentest outfit Syss at Full Disclosure. Even if you've installed the fixed versions that shipped in October – builds 1703 or 1709 – facial recognition has to be set up from scratch to make it resistant to the attack. The “simple spoofing attacks” described in the post are all variations on using a “modified printed photo of an authorized user” (a frontal photo, naturally) so an attacker can log into a locked Windows 10 system. The researchers tested their attack against a Dell Latitude running Windows 10 Pro, build 1703; and a Microsoft Surface Pro running 4 build 1607.
