ATMJackpot Malware Stealing Cash From ATMs

A new ATM malware has been identified by security researchers at Netskope Threat Research Labs. It has been dubbed as ATMJackpot (named after the technique called ATM jackpotting). Initial investigation revealed that the malware originated from Hong Kong while the time stamp binary is identified to be 28th March 2018. Apparently, the malware is in its developmental phase yet because, in comparison to other, previously discovered malware, ATMJackpot has limited features. Such as its graphical UI is quite basic and only displays the hostname and information about the service providers (e.g. PIN pad, card reader and cash dispenser service providers).
