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Macy's Warns Customers about Recent Data Breach

Macy's is warning customers that a cyberthreat targeted customer information for nearly two months. The retailer mailed a letter to customers who shopped on macys.com after its security tools detected "suspicious login activities" by a third party on June 11. The third party had access to customer accounts from April 26 to June 12, according to the company letter. The third party likely was able to access the customer's name, address, phone number, email address, birthday and credit or debit card number with expiration dates. Customers should change their online profile information and passwords if they were notified about the breach or suspect suspicious activity on their account.
