Twitter Suspends Guccifer 2.0 and DCLeaks Accounts after Indictments

The Guccifer 2.0 and DCLeaks Twitter accounts were both suspended on Saturday, one day after special counsel Robert Mueller alleged in an indictment that the accounts were run by Russian military officers. The Guccifer 2.0 account was briefly suspended in 2016 after it released contact information for nearly 200 current and former members of Congress. Both accounts have been inactive for at least 18 months. Mueller indicted 12 Russian intelligence agents on Friday for the 2016 hack of the Democratic National Committee (DNC). He alleged that the agents used the Twitter accounts to share documents stolen from the Democrats and Democratic presidential candidate Hillary Clinton's camp. Guccifer 2.0 had maintained that he was a Romanian hacker with no political ties, and DCLeaks had claimed that it was a watchdog group.
