## **Facebook Faces another Privacy Scandal**

Another day, another data exposure for a large tech company. A photo API bug gave third-party app developers access to people's Facebook photos, the company announced in post on Thursday [link]. Facebook estimates the bug affected up to 6.8 million users, as well as 1,500 apps built by 876 developers. These weren't just photos people shared to their public timelines, however. This bug also included photos posted to Facebook marketplace, Facebook stories and photos uploaded to Facebook that were never actually shared. The exposure lasted from Sept. 13 to Sept. 25, at which point Facebook was able to fix the bug.
